**PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:**

A unique one-step aerosol formulation that restores or changes the color of vinyl surfaces and low-pile carpets. Ideal for use on car interiors, vinyl boat interiors, vinyl motorcycle seats, vinyl office furniture, vinyl luggage, vinyl outdoor furniture, and auto and boat carpeting. Computer matched to OEM standards. 12 colors! All dyes are Packed 12 cans per case. California/OTC and VOC Compliant.

**DIRECTIONS:**

***FOR USE ON VINYL:*** Clean surface thoroughly with #713 Special Cleaner to remove grease, grime, silicone treatments, etc. Mask off areas not to be coated and surrounding areas to protect these surfaces from overspray. Test a small area for compatibility before proceeding. Use at room temperature of 70°- 80°F (21°-27° C) with adequate ventilation only. Shake can for one minute after mixing ball rattles and occasionally between coats. With point opening of spray nozzle approximately 12-14 inches from surface, move can back and forth with a mist coat and allow to dry. If clogging develops, remove spray button with a twisting motion and clean. Do not stick pin or other object into can. Gently replace spray button with a twisting motion with top of can and spray button opening pointing away from you. Follow with several thin coats to achieve desired results. If coating sags or runs, you are too close or applying too heavily. Clean spray button immediately after use by turning can upside down and pressing spray button until no paint comes out. Allow 24 hours before areas are exposed to body friction such as car seats, etc.

***FOR USE ON CARPETING:*** Utilizing the same directions above, while applying thin coats, use a stiff nylon brush to keep fibers separated while drying. Repeat process until color is even. This product is not recommended for use on long nap carpets.
