PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Power Cut Plus® is a fast-cutting compound for removing heavy oxidation, acid rain spots, deep sand scratches and car wash scratches on aged and fresh paint. Safe for use on clear coat and conventional paint finishes. May be applied by hand or a variable speed polisher. Works well with wool or foam cutting pads. VOC compliant. Body shop safe.

DIRECTIONS:

Shake well before using. For best results use with a Malco 100% white wool cutting pad. Apply a 2" dab of Power Cut Plus compound for a 2' x 2' section and spread with the cutting pad. Buff at speed between 1600 - 2200 rpm. Work the buffer slowly from side to side and front to rear until most of the product is gone and gloss appears. Repeat as necessary until scratches are removed. For optimal finish, follow with a finishing polish or wax for bringing the compounded surface back to a showroom finish.

SURFACE APPLICATIONS:

For compounding clear coat, single stage, acrylic, lacquers, enamels, as well as powder-coated paints.

ADDITIONAL USES:

Excellent on RVs, boats, motorcycles, ATVs, and other painted surfaces. Power Cut Plus® works great as a headlight lens repair product.

HELPFUL TIPS:

Follow Power Cut Plus® with a polish and wax (wax for optional added gloss and protection).
